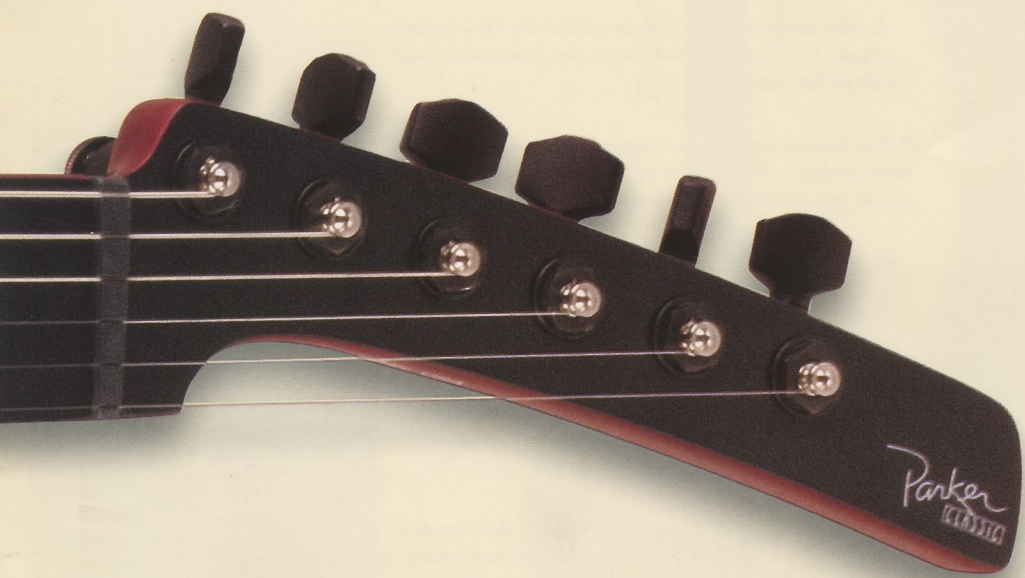

B. Custom-wound DiMarzio® humbuckers are mounted directly to the body with two pole-piece screws. The results are superior tone and sustain.

C. The optional Parker Fly vibrato bridge is manufactured of premium steel and high strength aluminum resulting in a lightweight, ultra-responsive system. You can select free-floating, bend-down-only, or fixed modes.

D. The Fishman® active-piezo pickup system custom-designed for the Parker Fly delivers the rich, lush sound of an acoustic guitar at any volume level.

E. The master volume lets you adjust the Fly's overall volume level and controls both the humbucker and piezo pickup systems.

F. The humbucker volume lets you adjust the level of these pickups. Since it works independently of the piezos, you get maximum control over your sound.

G. A three-position humbucker selector lets you choose the neck pickup, neck/bridge inside coils for that "in between" sound, or the bridge pickup.

H. The humbucker tone control, like the humbucker volume control, is completely independent of the piezos. It provides increased flexibility to custom-tailor your guitar's sound.

I. The piezo/magnetic three-position switch lets you select or combine the two pickup systems allowing output that goes from full electric to full acoustic, or a blend of both with your choice of split stereo or mono.

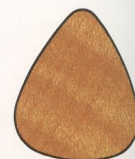
J. The piezo volume controls the level of this pickup system. Since it works independently of the humbuckers, you can dial in the exact amount of acoustic guitar sound you choose.

K. The piezo tone control, like piezo volume, is totally independent from the humbucker system. It adds flexibility and lets you precisely control the tone of the Fly's active-piezo pickup system.

L. The unique balance wheel lets you adjust the tension of the Fly's vibrato system.

The stereo/mono, push-button switch (located near the output jack) and the special cable provided with the Fly allow you the choice of sending the acoustic and electric signals to two different amplifiers, or a mixed signal to one amplifier.

The Parker Fly Deluxe, Classic and Supreme share the same advanced features.

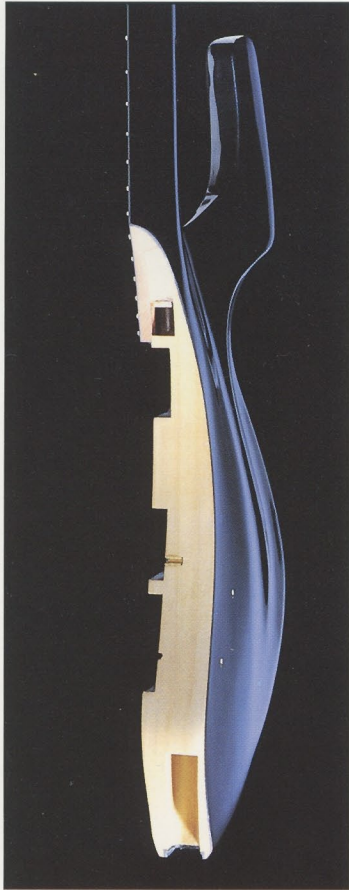

Classic and Supreme: A perfect blend of modern technology and old world craft.

All Parker Flies are made of solid tonewoods chosen for their great response and sustain. The backs of the neck and body are strengthened and unified by a thin layer of carbon/glass/epoxy composite. (When we say thin, we mean thinner than the paint!) It's this patented process that enables a Fly to be so thin and light in weight, yet so amazingly strong and responsive. The fingerboard is composed of the same materials. It's ultra-fast, unusually stable and highly wear-resistant.

Figured-maple guitars have always been loved for their incredible look and tone. For the Fly Supreme, Parker painstakingly crafts a one-piece, flame-maple body to create an instrument that's incredibly dynamic and well balanced – from lows through highs. This light weight masterpiece features twenty-four frets, like all Parker Flies, and is available in a Transparent Honey finish. The Fly Supreme comes with a Hiscox molded, hard-shell case.

A solid, one-piece Honduras Mahogany body gives the Parker Fly Classic a rich look and tone. It yields a chunky sound with a fat, sweet midrange. Light in weight, like all Flies, the Classic is available in a Transparent Cherry or Root Beer Metallic finish. The mahogany used for this guitar is sustainably harvested in Central America, so we're not depleting the world's rain forest resources. The Classic comes with a Hiscox molded, hard-shell case.

At less than five pounds, the Fly Deluxe may be the lightest guitar you've ever played, yet it has the punch of a heavyweight. It's available in ten stunning custom colors and comes with a high quality, plush Levy® gig bag. From its resonant tonewoods to its hand-rubbed high gloss finish, the Fly Deluxe has redefined what a solid body guitar should be.

The NiteFly is Parker's first bolt-on-neck guitar. It features a solid, contoured, maple body and shares many of the Fly's advancements. Like a basswood neck reinforced with Parker's patented carbon/glass/epoxy composite. And a fingerboard constructed of the same smooth, stable, extremely durable material.

The NiteFly's twenty-two jumbo frets are also made of spring-tempered, stainless steel and are precision surface-mounted for accurate tuning and extra-long life.

The NiteFly features both magnetic and passive, piezo-transducer pickup systems; and it comes with a high quality Levy® gig bag. The NiteFly is versatile, affordable and available in five beautiful finishes.

C. Custom designed DiMarzio® are available in your choice of humbucker/single/single or three single coil configuration.

D. The NiteFly's stay-in-tune vibrato system utilizes a premium steel and high strength aluminum bridge that can operate in either free-floating or bend-down-only modes.

E. A Fishman® passive, piezo-transducer system mounted in the bridge provides the beautiful rich sound of an acoustic guitar.

F. The magnetic pickup volume control allows you to adjust the level of these pickups. Since it works independently of the piezo-pickup system, you get maximum control over your sound.

G. The five position selector switch lets you choose between the neck, neck/middle "in between sound," middle, middle/bridge "in between sound," or bridge magnetic pickups.

H. The magnetic pickup tone control, like its corresponding volume control, is completely independent of the piezos. It provides increased flexibility in achieving the sound you want.

I. The piezo-magnetic three-position switch lets you select or combine the two pickup systems allowing output that goes from full electric to full acoustic, or a blend of both.

J. The piezo volume controls the level of this pickup system. Since it works independently of the magnetic pickups, you can choose the exact amount of acoustic guitar sound you want.
